## Call for Posters

The Latino Health Forum will provide the opportunity to display a poster during the forum to foster the dissemination and discussion of best practices, research, and innovative projects to address health care access, health equity, and community engagement among Latinos. The topic of the poster will address an issue which impacts Latino health and will fall under one of four categories: **clinical services, advocacy/policy, research, or community-based health promotion**. This is a great opportunity for you to present your ideas, research, and/or project to an audience that is interested in your topic and can directly benefit from your work.

All poster topics must impact Latino health. Potential themes could be the following, however are not limited to: violence, trauma, disease management and prevention, community-based initiatives impacting Latino health, Latino engagement, culturally-tailored programming to improve service efficacy, policy affecting Latino health, access to care or social justice issues and the impact each of these topics have on Latino health.

### **Poster Submission Process**

Please submit an abstract of no more than 300 words on the attached document with the following components:

- **Purpose and Problem** – What was the goal of the project or research and the problem to be addressed?
- **Description** – What was the methodology used?
- **Evaluation and Outcomes** – What were the outcomes of the project or findings of the research?
- **Discussion** – What do the findings tell us? Was your goal met? What were the limitations?
